



**Alberdingk Boley, Inc Announces Price Increases for
All Products Sold in North America Including Dispersions and Emulsions
Effective December 1, 2007**

ALBERDINGK BOLEY, Inc announced a price increase today for all products including dispersion and emulsions sold in North America shipped on or after December 1, 2007.

Prices on all polyurethane dispersions will increase by \$0.10 per wet pound, including standard and solvent free PUDs, castor oil based PUDs, polyurethane hybrids and copolymers, and UV curable dispersions. All other ABI products including emulsion products will increase by \$0.06 per wet pound, including acrylics, styrene acrylics, acrylic epoxy hybrids, self cross linking and hydroxy functional acrylics, opaque polymers, castor oil-based polyols, and Albolith molecular sieve paste.

This increase is driven by increasing raw material and packaging costs as well as rising operating expenses. Customers wanting to learn more about the price increase should contact their respective Alberdingk sales representative.
